Maths H1 will look at multiplication and division. We will count, make and add equal groups and create and interpret arrays.

B1/2 Year 1 will also be focusing on multiplication, division and fractions. Year 2 will be concentrating on the 4 calculations, reasoning and measure. P2 will be measuring length and mass, then revising all aspects of number.

Art Children will develop their collage skills by cutting and tearing. They will study the artist Andy Brown and look at the Crown Jewels. Then they will design and make their own crown for our class jubilee party.

Computing Children will be learning about Spreadsheets.

We will be investigating the life of Queen Elizabeth II and creating a timeline to show the significant events in her life, with a focus on her coronation.

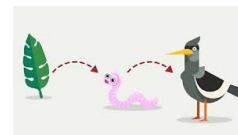

Science— H1 & B1/2 will be

learning about objects that are living, dead or never been alive. They will also learn about basic needs of animals and humans and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants. They will learn about simple food chains.



P2 will be investigating what plants and animals need for their survival. We will be planting seeds and bulbs to explore how different factors can effect the rate of growth. We will further explore animals in their habitats.

English In English this half term, we will be reading the story 'Brian Bear's Picnic'. We will write a retell and character descriptions. For the rest of the half term, we will be reading non-fiction texts to find information about Queen Elizabeth's life, Coronation and the upcoming Platinum Jubilee.
