

Year 1 and 2 Curriculum Letter Spring 2 2022

Maths

P2 To begin this half term, we will be exploring fractions and finding equal parts. We will then begin a new topic of measurement, where we will focus on length, height, mass, capacity and temperature. There will be a range of practical investigations for the children to get stuck into!

B1/2 Y1 will begin a new topic of measurement, where we will focus on length & height, weight & volume. There will be a range of practical investigations for the children to get stuck into!

Y2- will be learning about multiplication & division. Money and fractions.

H1 - In maths this half term we will be exploring place value up to 50, understanding the value of each number in a two-digit number. We will be ordering and comparing numbers and finding one more and one less than any given number within 50.

DT

Our focus on DT this half term will be to construct a shelter with a light. We will explore which materials will be the most suitable and link to our learning in Science by creating an electrical circuit.

Science

In Science this half term the children will find out about the different materials that objects can be made from. They will sort and classify them and will investigate how they change by squashing, stretching, twisting and bending. They will describe the physical properties of materials and explain which materials are most suitable for different purposes. We will also be constructing a simple series electrical circuit.



PE

Indoor PE—Dance (The Zoo) focusing on body parts.

Outdoor PE—Feet skills (using balls to dribble, kick and control the ball).



Music

The children will continue to work with our specialist Music teacher. They have the opportunity to play the keyboards, drums and melodicas.

RE

We will be listening to and asking questions about stories of individuals and their relationship with God.

English

In English all classes will be looking at 'Where We Are' for World Book week and write a letter to the aliens. We will then have 'Lion Learners' visiting school to teach us about different animal types. The children will then learn about recounts and write about the visit.

P2 and **B1/2** will go on to read 'The Winter's Child' and we will write descriptions and a letter.

H1 will go on to read 'The Storm' and continue to develop our skills in writing interesting sentences for character descriptions and story retells.

Computing

In computing this half term, we will use technology to create spreadsheets and pictograms. We will explore a range of different types of data before the children have a go at constructing their own graph.

PSHE

The topic this half term is 'happy and healthy me'. We will explore: body parts, personal hygiene, a balanced diet and the spread of germs and diseases.
