

Year 1 Curriculum Letter Spring 2 2022

Maths In maths this half term we will be exploring place value up to 50, understanding the value of each number in a two-digit number. We will be ordering and comparing numbers and finding one more and one less than any given number within 50. We will also continue to develop our understanding of measuring length and height and learning how we can measure weight and volume

Science In science this half term the children will find out about the different materials that objects can be made from. They will sort and classify them and will investigate how they change by squashing, stretching, twisting and bending. They will describe the physical properties of materials and explain which materials are most suitable for different purposes. We will also be constructing a simple series electrical circuit.



English

In English we will be looking at 'Here We Are' for World Book week and write a letter to the aliens. We will then have 'Lion Learners' visiting school to teach us about different animal types. The children will then learn about writing a recount and move on to write their own version of the events of the day. We will then continue to develop our skills in writing interesting sentences for character descriptions and story retells.

DT

In DT this half term will be designing and making a weatherproof shelter with a light. Linked to Science we will initially explore the properties of a materials in order to select the most suitable and then create an electrical circuit which will light a bulb.

PE

RE

We will be listening to and asking questions about stories of individuals and their relationship with God.



Music The children will continue to work with our specialist Music teacher. They have the opportunity to play the keyboards, steel drums and melodicas.

Computing

In computing this half term, we will use technology to create spreadsheets and pictograms. We will explore a range of different types of data before the children have a go at constructing their own graph.

PSHE The topic this half term is 'happy and healthy me'. We will explore: body parts, personal hygiene, the spread of germs and diseases and a balanced diet.
