

YEAR 3/4

MATHS

We will continue to look at multiplication and division. We will also be looking at area and fractions.

Children will be set a weekly piece of homework on Mathematics and should also practise their Times Tables using TT Rockstars.



English

We shall be looking at *The Firework Maker's Daughter* and *Escape from Pompeii*. We will be producing narrative writing. Please hear your child read every night and practise weekly spellings with them for their spelling test. Work will also be set on Reading Eggs every week.



History

We shall look at the Romans in our history lessons. The children will learn about different aspects of Roman life, including the Roman army.

A Roman soldier will be visiting school on Friday 7th January.



Computing

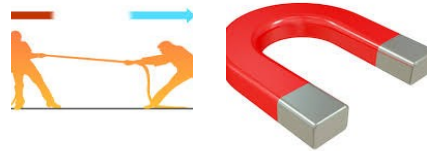
This half-term we will be looking at spreadsheets using the Purple Mash program.

Science

Geography

We shall learn about the places that were part of the Roman Empire. This will develop children's knowledge of locations around the world.



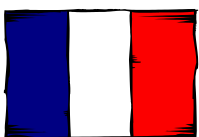
PSHE

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

A piece of Maths and Reading homework is set on the BGfL (Mathletics and Reading Eggs) and there are also additional tasks set linked to other subjects.
