## MATHS

We will continue to focus on fractions (Y4 will also look at the relationship between fractions and decimals). We will also look at statistics.

Children will be set a weekly piece of homework on Mathematics and should also practise their Times Tables using TT Rockstars.

Please also use the learning platform to support your child's learning.



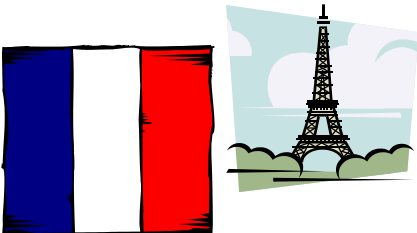
## DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY

## English

Following this, children will study the book 'Varjak Paw' written by S.F.Said. They will learn about different features of play scripts and then rewrite part of the story in this genre.

H3 will be continuing with violin lessons on Monday afternoons. C4 and J34 will create Roman marching music and learn songs based on our Romans topic.



## RE

This term we shall learn about the traditions of special foods. Children will design a dish for a religious festival.

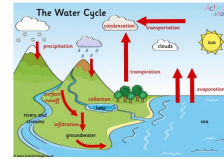


## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Every week your child has spellings to learn and they should be reading regularly (e.g. 10 minutes, five times weekly with a brief comment in the reading diary each time). The changing of reading books is now the responsibility of each pupil. A piece of Maths and Reading homework is set on the BGfL (Mathletics and Reading Eggs) and there are also additional tasks set linked to other subjects.
