Year 1/2 Curriculum Letter Autumn 2 2022

Maths v1— We will be using part-part whole models to support our learning of addition and subtraction with 1-digit numbers.

T1/2— We will be also be using part-part whole models to support our learning of addition and subtraction with both 1-digit numbers and 2-digit numbers.

P2— We will begin by continuing our learning of addition and subtraction with 2-digit numbers.

Following this, we will start a new topic of geometry, learning about a range of 2-D and 3-D shapes.

Science In Science this half term the children will be learning about things that are living, dead and have never been alive. We will then be moving on to learning about the human body, a range of materials, light, sound and electricity.

English This half term we will be researching information on castles and writing a non-fiction information report.

Following this, the books we will be using as a basis for our work are 'How to Kick Start a Dragon' and 'Sir Charlie Stinking Socks'.

There will be a focus on developing story language and different forms of punctuation.
The children will write stories, character descriptions and recounts.

<u>DT</u> This half term will be based around the children designing and building their own castles. This will involve many skills such as joining materials together, folding, curling and creating hinges.
