MATHS

We will be partitioning, ordering, and adding and subtracting numbers as well as learning what each digit represents.

The children will continue to improve their mental mathematics strategies through weekly arithmetic activities.

We will also be looking at improving times tables skills by following the TT Rock Stars programme. Please use the children's completed times tables tests to practise.

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Computing

This half-term we will look at coding using the Purple Mash program.

PSHE

In PSHE lessons this half-term, the focus is Me and My School. We will be looking at class rules, school council elections and new challenges.



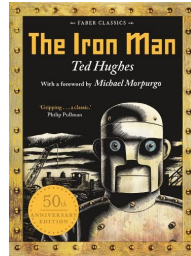
FRENCH

This term we will be starting to learn simple conversational French.



English

We are reading the Iron Man, with a particular focus on diary writing. We will continue with this book later in the term as we look at writing instructions.

History

We will learn about the Ancient Egyptians, including their way of life, their traditions, their culture and their role in history.



Violin

C34 will start learning how to play the violin on Tuesday afternoons. J3 and H4 will look at and create music based on our topic of the Egyptians.



RE

Our theme this half term is looking at the environment and different creation stories from a variety of religions.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Science
