


Numeracy

We will be focussing on fractions this half-term. The children will learning how to : recognise, find and write fractions of a discrete set of objects, understand unit fractions and non-unit fractions with small denominators, find equivalent fractions, add fractions and relate fractions to decimals (Y4 only)

The children will continue to improve their mental mathematics strategies through weekly mental maths activities and will be improving their times tables by following TT ROCK STARS and Mathletics. <u>Fractions</u>



ICT

In ICT, the children will learn how to use a spreadsheet in Excel to input and organise data collected. The children will be recording data using the school weather station as part of the unit 'We are Meteorologists'.



RE

Our RE unit is entitled 'Commitment'. We will be looking at how commitment can affect the lives of believers.



FRENCH

This half term, our topic is Raconte -moi une histoire (Tell me a story). This will improve the children's awareness of simple adjective agreement and French sounds/ spellings in the context of a fairy tale.

Literacy

Our theme is stories from imaginary worlds. We will be reading the Ice Palace by Robert Swindells.

In science, we will be writing a persuasive letter to highlight the dangers to a variety of habitats around the world.
