
Year 6

Numeracy

This term we will be focusing on a new unit each week in order to cover all topics necessary for the SATs. The units this half term include rotation and translation, statistics and time. The remaining weeks will be used to revise any areas that we need to revisit.

During the half term we will also run a practise SATs week which will mirror the real Mathematics papers to inform on-going assessments.



On Tuesdays we will practise reasoning questions in pairs, groups or independently to develop our problem solving skills and on Thursday we will practise arithmetic questions.

Before each Numeracy lesson, we will review the answers to the CPG task that would have been set the previous day. This will provide another means of practising the different question types and strands of Numeracy. It is therefore very important that pupils complete all homework. Please remember to have your revision pack in school every day.

Literacy

During World Book Week we will write a newspaper report about *The Snorgh and the Sailor*. After Laches Wood, we will write a recount then begin a three-week unit around the famous poem, *The Highway Man*. We will produce descriptive writing based on this text.

Spelling

Pupils will receive spellings each week to learn at home and these will be tested on Monday. We will also have a weekly spelling lesson.

Grammar


We will run a grammar test every week so that pupils can practise the question types. We will then discuss the answers to address any issues. Most grammar teaching will be within Literacy lessons when pupils have the chance to learn and apply their grammar knowledge. In addition, we will have a short daily grammar session during which we will use the CGP books.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All pupils in Year 6 have been asked to attend Maths Booster Sessions every Tuesday and Thursday morning. This is for the weeks leading up to SATs and will be very valuable. Pupils should arrive at 8am and a free breakfast will be provided.

Science

This term we will learn about the solar system, focusing mainly on the movement of the earth, sun and moon.



Homework

Due to the upcoming SATs tests, the Year 6 pupils will receive more regular homework. Every day, we will set a piece of Maths homework which must be brought to school to be marked the following day. **Every Monday we will set a** longer reading task. Pupils have a week to complete this and we will discuss the answers on the following Monday. The pupils will continue to receive a list of ten spellings to learn each week. This is valuable preparation for the SATs test so please take time to practise.
