

## Communication and Language and Literacy

We will...

- Recognise digraphs, trigraphs and adjacent consonants in longer words and use them to read and write simple sentences with capital letters and full stops.
- Listen attentively and respond to what we hear when being read to and during whole class discussions.
- Learn new vocabulary about minibeasts
- Offer explanations for why things might happen making use of recently learned vocabulary
- Ask questions to find out more
- To hold back and forth conversations
- To listen to and remember key information

## Mathematics

We will...

- Have a deep understanding of number to 10, including addition and subtraction facts
- Automatically recall number bonds to 5 and some to 10, including subtraction facts
- To know double facts within 10
- To know odd and even numbers to 10

- To form letters correctly and write words quickly
- Draw pictures with accuracy and care
- Negotiate space with consideration for others during P.E lessons and when playing outside
- Develop control, co-ordination and aim with balls during P.E
- Move energetically, such as running, skipping, jumping, hopping, dancing and climbing
