
Year 1/2 Curriculum Letter Summer 2 2022

<u>Maths</u> B1/2 - The year 1 children are focusing on fractions, place value to 100, money and time. Year 2 children are learning about measurement e.g length and height, mass, capacity and temperature. H1 will be finding and recognising halves of shapes ad quantities. P2 will be focusing on measurement this half term. We will be looking at weighing objects in grams and kilograms, measuring capacity with volume and recording length in centimetres and metres. We will also focus on securing our times tables this half term. **Science** In Science this half term the children will be discovering what is meant by a "habitat" and a "microhabitat" and what kind of plants and animals have habitats and micro-habitats at the seaside. They will consider how different habitats are adapted to suit the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants and how they depend on each other.

PE In Outdoor PE the children will be following a unit called "Amazing Athletics", working on developing the skills they will need for Sports Day. In Indoor PE they will be working on improving agility, balance and co-ordination through the use of circuits




Please find overleaf a list of topic words that it would be useful to make sure your child understands at home to help with their learning.

Geography Geography lessons this half term will see the children identifying human and physical features of the British seaside compared to Burton on Trent.

History In History the children will be discovering who Grace Darling was and why she is believed to be a significant figure in History. They will look at artefacts from the time and considering why she is remembered today. **English** we will begin this half term by reading and exploring "The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch", describing food, writing instructions and exploring the emotions and feelings of the characters. Later, we shall write explanations linked to our seaside topic, before rehearsing and

performing a selection of seaside poems. Please still make sure that you are reading with your child every day, checking that they understand what they have read and developing their love for reading in general.
