

Year 1/2 Curriculum Letter Autumn 1 2019

Maths Year 1 will begin by exploring numbers to 10. They will read and write numbers in words and numerals and compare and order them.

Year 2 will begin by exploring numbers, and in particular Place Value, before developing their skills of addition and subtraction.

Next week you will receive your child's username and password for Mathletics! Please try to log on as often as possible and help your child achieve awards and certificates.

Art This half term the children will be using the work of Roy Lichtenstein to inspire their own Pop Art style paintings. They will be mixing primary colours to create secondary colours and also discovering how to make colours lighter and darker.



RE Our RE topic will explore the idea of belonging and caring, discussing how people show that they care.

Music The children will work with our specialist Music teacher. They will also learn songs for our upcoming Harvest Festival.

Science In Science this half term the children will be learning to identify and name plants and trees, before beginning to decide whether animals are carnivores, omnivores or herbivores. We will then identify and label different parts of the body.



Superheroes

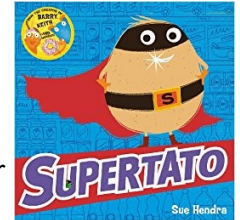
Please remember to remove ear rings for PE days and if your child attends multi-skills after school.

PSHE During this half term we will focus on developing our class rules, and making sure they understand their role and contribution to the life of the school. We will also vote in our new school councillors.

DT This half term the children will be designing and making a healthy food product, having first decided which foods help to keep them healthy. They will design, make, evaluate and improve their ideas.

English Linking with

our Superheroes topic, we will be reading Supertato and Traction Man, using these texts to inspire their own writing, such as character descriptions and a wanted poster.



They will continue learning their phonics and spellings and will be learning further rules in grammar, as well as developing their use of punctuation. Please ensure your child reads every day.

History We will find out about significant people from the past who were real-life superheroes, such as Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole.

PE This half term the children will be developing their balancing skills during our multi-skills sessions. In Boot Camp, the children will work to increase their heart rate and develop agility and co-ordination.

Computing We will be working on basic computing skills this half term, such as how to log on, open and save documents and manipulate texts (for example, enlarging the text or changing the font).
