





<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Year 1 will begin by exploring numbers to 10. They will read and write numbers in words and numerals, comparing and ordering them.</p> <p>Year 2 will begin by exploring numbers and place value before developing their skills of addition and subtraction.</p> <p>You will soon receive your child's username and password for Mathletics. Please try to log on as often as possible to enable your child to achieve awards and certificates.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>The children will be learning to identify and name a range of plants and trees. We will learn about evergreen and deciduous trees and how they differ. We will then learn about animals and whether they are carnivores, omnivores or herbivores and what these mean. As part of our lessons, we will be learning new scientific vocabulary and investigating by asking and answering questions.</p> 	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>This half term our main text will be Supertato. We will be using different aspects of the story to inspire the children to produce their own writing in different genres. We will also be focussing on lots of grammar skills using our Grammarsaurus curriculum. Daily reading and phonics will develop their reading and spelling skills.</p> <p>Please ensure your child reads every day.</p> 	
<p><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>We will be developing our class rules and helping the children understand the value their role has in the contribution to school life. We will be using our 1 Decision PSHE curriculum.</p>	<p>KS1 Curriculum letter</p> <p>Autumn 1</p>		<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>Our RE topic will explore the idea of belonging and caring. The children will discuss and learn about things people care about and how we demonstrate care.</p>
<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>We will be learning how to be geographers and conducting a local fieldwork study to find out more about our local area. We will look at rural and urban areas.</p> 	<p><u>History</u></p> <p>We will be finding out about The Gunpowder plot. Through this unit, we will look at what happened, who was involved and the important places linked to the plot. We will use historical sources to find out about the past just like real historians. We will finish by looking at how this event is remembered today.</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>The children will be developing their dancing skills with the theme of 'Growing'. Outdoor PE will focus on jumping and how to be a champion jumper. Please ensure children wear kit in line with school policy and have earrings removed.</p>	
<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>The children will be listening to and talking about music. They will sing and use percussion to explore music. We will also be practising songs for our Harvest celebration assembly.</p> 	<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>We will be working on basic computing skills and how to be more independent at logging on and saving work. We will learn about online safety and keeping passwords safe. Some of our computing work will be linked to art this term.</p>	<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>We will be looking at the work of Julian Opie, a contemporary artist whose work is cartoon like. The children will look at his work and produce their own portrait in his style using a computer programme.</p>
