

Maths Year 1 will begin by exploring numbers to 10. They will read and write numbers in words and numerals and compare and order them.

Year 2 will begin by exploring numbers, and in particular Place Value, before developing their skills of addition and subtraction.

Next week you will receive your child's username and password for Mathletics! Please try to log on as often as possible and help your child achieve awards and certificates.

Science In Science this half term the children will be learning to identify and name common plants and trees, before beginning to investigate whether animals are carnivores, omnivores or herbivores. We will then identify and label different parts of the body.

English

In English we will begin our grammar focus work and explore stories such as The Gruffalo and Stick Man.

The children will continue to learn their phonics and spellings and will be learning further rules in.

This term we are beginning a whole school focus on handwriting so look out for further information and guidance in the coming weeks.
