

# **Y3/4 Curriculum Letter – Autumn 2 2025**

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **Homework**

Each week, your child will be set a writing homework task to complete in their homework books. This will be found on their class page on the BGFL in J2Bloggy. Children will also be set homework on Reading Eggs and Mathletics. **Please hear your child read at home and record in their diary – thank you.**

### **PE**

Class J3 will have PE on Mondays and Fridays, R4 Tuesdays and Fridays and EH34 Mondays (swimming Fridays).

EH34 will continue their swimming lessons on Friday 14th November. Please ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit on these days.

No earrings are permitted to be worn in lessons. Please ensure that if children cannot remove earrings independently, then they should let an adult take them out before school on PE days.

In PE lessons, this half-term we will be improving our netball and dance skills.

### **MATHS**

This half-term we will be looking at multiplication and division with particular focus on times tables facts. Children will be set a weekly piece of homework on Mathletics and should also practise their Times Tables using TT Rockstars.

### **ENGLISH**

We will be reading Adolphus Tips. Using the book, the children will write an informal letter, a diary entry and a story. We will continue to improve our spelling (using the Grammarsaurus program) use a wider vocabulary, produce more exciting and challenging texts, and develop our use of a range of punctuation.

### **SCIENCE**

This half-term we will continue to learn about a variety of science topics including :magnetism, light and electricity.

### **COMPUTING**

This term we will be looking at using the Internet safely using the Purple Mash program. Please also use the learning platform to support your child's learning.

### **PSHE**

Our theme for this half-term is staying safe using the One Decision programme.

## **GEOGRAPHY**

We will be looking at The Lake District, the water cycle and cloud formation.

## **HISTORY**

We will continue to learn about the Bronze Age and then look at the transition into the Iron Age.

## **RE**

Our theme this half term is landmarks in life.

## **DT**

In DT this half-term, the children will be designing and making their own light up card.

## **FRENCH**

This half term we will be looking at following and writing instructions in French.

## **VIOLIN/MUSIC**

J3 will continue to play the violin on Tuesday afternoons – there will be a concert in school for parents and family members in school on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> December at 2:30pm. R4 and EH34 will be working from our Music Express units.
