

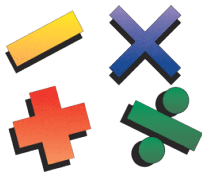
Year 5 Autumn 2

It is important that pupils continue to practise their times tables as all pupils must be secure with multiplication and division facts up to 12x12.



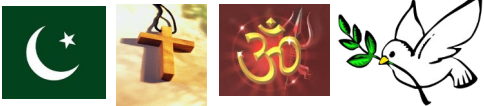
Computing

RE

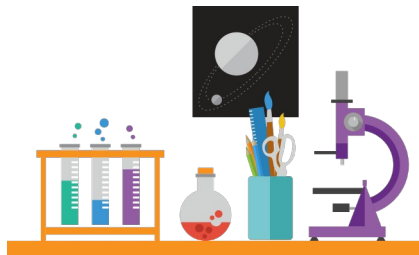
This term we shall identify ideas and values linked to the theme of 'Peace'.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
