



<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Year 1 We will be learning about larger numbers. We will be working with numbers larger than 20, looking at place value. Later we will be working on length, height, mass and volume.</p> <p>Year 2 We will begin by learning about grouping objects into equal and unequal groups and then focusing on division and multiplication for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>In science we will be learning about living things and how animals have offspring that grow into adults. We will learn about materials and their properties and categorise objects, explaining our reasons. We will investigate whether the shape of materials can be changed by bending, stretching, squashing or twisting them and will be constructing simple electrical circuits.</p>	<p><u>English</u></p> <p>In English we re all going to be focusing on books linked to emotions and feelings and will link this work to our PSHE. We will be celebrating World Book Day in school and many of us will be dressing up as our favourite book characters. Within our writing, we will be consolidating our work on sentence c9nstruction and the consistent use of punctuation. We will develop our use of conjunctions in order to write longer compound sentences that engage the reader and give additional information.</p> <p>Please ensure your child reads every day.</p>
<p><u>PSHE</u></p> <p>We will continue using our PSHE curriculum One Decision and think about hazards in and around our environment. We will talk about how to stay safe and what to do. It will involve making decisions about what is safe to eat and drink and what is safe or unsafe to play with.</p>	<p>KS1 Curriculum letter Spring 2</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>In RE we will learning all about different types of families and how all families are different. We will look at how families take care of one another and support each other as well as finding out about how members of a church are like a family in the way they behave towards each other.</p>
<p><u>Geography</u></p>  <p>In Geography we will be learning about the continents and oceans of the world. We will also identify countries in each continent and learn the order of the oceans by size. We will learn the seas which surround the UK and then do some work with grid references on maps.</p>	<p><u>History</u></p> <p>In history we will be learning about Florence Nightingale. We will place when she was born on the class time line and make comparisons with the dates of the other events from history we have learned about. We will find out about the life of Florence Nightingale and why she is important. We will explore her actions during the Crimean war and how she improved conditions for soldiers.</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>In outdoor P.E we will be keeping fit by looking at ball skills, working on kicking and passing the ball. We will develop our dribbling skills and apply this into small games. In Indoor PE we will be doing dance. It will be based around zoo animals and how they move.</p> <p>Make sure to wear plain black P.E kit and remove all jewellery for P.E days.</p> 
<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>We will be continuing our musical learning on Music Express and we will be based on the theme of Our Bodies. We will be learning to clap and play different rhythms on instruments. We will continue to learn musical vocabulary and listen to music so that we can talk about features we can hear.</p>	<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>In computing we will using our Purple Mash curriculum to make an animated story book. We will also be doing some more work on internet safety. The children will learn what to do when something goes wrong and be clear about who to tell.</p>	<p><u>Design Technology</u></p> <p>In DT we will be looking at levers. The children will be finding out how levers work, looking at existing products and experiment making their own. They will design and make a product for picking up litter and then test it.</p>
