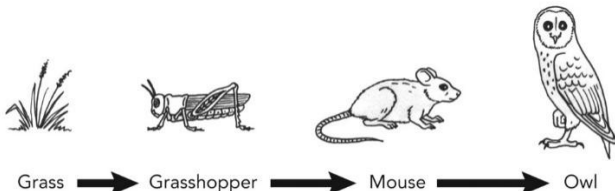
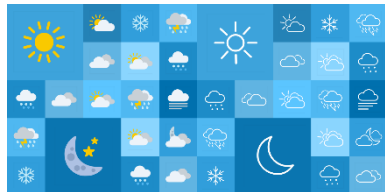


<u>Maths</u> Year 1 We will start our learning about multiplication and division and also begin to look at fractions. We will use a range of practical resources to help us with our maths learning and continue developing our reasoning skills. Year 2 We will be learning about length and height and mass and capacity. In length and height we will look at centimetres and meters. In mass and capacity we will look at measuring in grams and kilograms, litres and millilitres.	<u>Science</u> In science we will be looking at survival, thinking about how seeds and bulbs grow into plants and how they need water and light to help them grow. We will look at the basic survival needs of animals and also name some habitats and microhabitats. We will consider how important exercise is for health and begin to look at the idea of simple food chains. We will continue to learn the basics of good writing and build our stamina to write longer texts. We will continue to focus on our handwriting skills as well. <u>PSHE</u> We will continue using our PSHE curriculum One Decision. We will focus on the unit ‘Me and Other People’ looking at how our actions can affect other people and how to be good friends with one and other. <u>Geography</u> In Geography we will be learning about the weather. We will look at how the weather affects our daily lives, the different names for different weather types and also look at examples of extreme weather such as hurricanes and heatwaves. 	<u>History</u> In history we will be learning about Christopher Columbus.
