

Year 1/2 Curriculum Letter Summer 1 2023

Maths



Year 1: The year one children will focus on multiplication and division, followed by fractions.

Year 2: The children will consolidate their learning for addition/subtraction and multiplication and division and problem solving. They will apply their knowledge of number in a variety of real-life contexts.

Science In Science the children will investigate

materials. They will distinguish between an object and the material with which it is made and will describe its simple properties. The pupils will find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials for particular uses.

MATERIALS

Fire, fire!

DT We will be creating our own fire engine

using wheels, axis and chassis. The children will use cardboard and a range of materials to create their fire engine and make it move!



History In History the children will

be finding out about the Great Fire of London in order to describe an historical event. We will learn about famous people associated with the fire (Samuel Pepys and King Charles II) and will find out why they acted as they did.



PE The unit for outdoor PE this half term

is core strength. Each week, in outdoor PE, will be practising for sports day. Please ensure that outdoor PE kit is in school, including pumps or trainers.



Music The children will continue to work with our

specialist Music teacher and will use symbols to represent a composition and use them to help with a performance.

PSHE Our topic for PSHE this half term is

'Me and other people'. We will learn to identify and respect the differences and similarities between people



English

In English the children will learn about firefighters and their roles and responsibilities. We will be learning about the Great Fire of London and writing an information report using our knowledge.



Computing

The children will continue to practise logging on to the computers in the suite using their unique usernames and passwords. They will explore spreadsheets using Purple Mash, creating their own spreadsheet and understanding the key vocabulary such as cells, data, and inputting information.

RE

In RE the children will explore what makes a person good. They will listen to the story of Guru Nanak, the jasmine flower and the milk from the Sikh faith and relate the message to their own lives.
