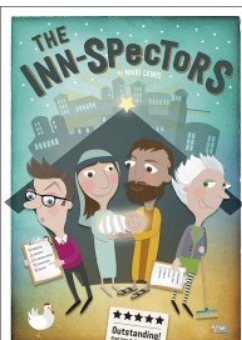
Dear Parents
