Dear Families,

As we approach the end of the half term it has been great to see how well all the children have returned and adapted to the new routines and systems in place.

Home-learning

The government have now made it a legal requirement that if any children are having to selfisolate then they must complete the 'Home learning' that is being provided for them. If this work is not completed and submitted to the class teacher then the child's absence will not be authorised and a fine may be incurred. All 'Home learning' can be found on the school learning platform, please contact the office if you do not have access to the internet or a device to work on.

COVID-19

If your child has symptoms of COVID-19 please remember to get a test at the earliest opportunity, test results are being returned very quickly and a negative result will mean your child can return to school as long as they remain well. The rest of the household also need to self-isolate (including siblings-brothers and sisters) until a negative test result is confirmed. If the test is positive then the symptomatic person will need to isolate for at least 10 days and at least 14 days isolation for the rest of the household. Please do not mix with other households during this time or allow the children to attend any clubs or outside engagements. Ensure you also inform school if your child or anyone in your household has a positive result. In adhering to these rules we help to keep each other safe and to keep the school operational as much as is possible.

It is now a time of coughs and colds and keeping up the routines of hand-washing and social distancing will help to minimise the spread of these viruses as well as COVID-19. We are pleased that so many of our families are adhering to the 'hands, face and space' protocols outside the school and urge you to continue to do so. As we approach the Winter months it is important that the children are dressed appropriately with winter coats, hats and gloves. At this time, we continue to minimise the amount of things coming into and out of school to reduce potential cross-contamination; children therefore **do not** need to bring a school bag.

Academy photographers will be in school tomorrow (Tuesday 20th October) to photograph your child. Under current restrictions we are not able to facilitate any family or sibling portraits.
