We would like to welcome everyone back after the half term break and we hope you all were able to enjoy a nice rest.

COVID-19

This month has brought us into a second lockdown period as the covid-19 infection rate has continued to rise. We have also experienced another bubble closing here at Christ Church as well as a few of our children and staff having to self-isolate. We must urge everyone that, although this can cause a lot of disruption, to please adhere to the government guidelines of ensuring that if you have symptoms you **must** get a test, you **must** isolate as soon as the symptoms appear and anyone in your household **must** also isolate if there is a positive test result within the household. Please inform the school office if you or anyone in your household has symptoms or has been told to isolate via 'Track and Trace'.

School has a responsibility to report anyone who is not following the rules. Please note that the government has introduced fines for people who break their self-isolation. If a member of staff becomes aware that parents/children are not following the rules, then they have duty of care to report them to the local authorities. We will contact you first, in case there is a permissible reason behind the rule break. Please do not be angry at school if they do make a report, we are just following the guidance, to try and keep us all safe. Please note when waiting outside of school to follow social distancing rules and ensure your children do the same as well as following the government message of 'Hands, Face and Space'.

Home-learning

As previously mentioned the government have now made it a legal requirement that if any children are having to self-isolate then they must complete the 'Home learning' that is being provided for them. Most of our children are now able to access this this successfully and have been able to submit their work to their teachers either on line or on paper. If you are having any problems with accessing this work please let the school office know so that we can provide assistance. We must also remind you that if this work is not completed and submitted to the class teacher then the child's absence will not be authorised and a fine may be incurred.

Remembrance day

This year we marked Remembrance day by all the children creating their own poppies using a variety of materials. We would like to thank all of our families for their generous donations as we raised £ 217.50!
