Covid-19 updates



COVID-19

If your child has symptoms of COVID-19 please remember to get a PCR test at the earliest opportunity, test results are being returned very quickly and a negative result will mean your child can return to school as long as they remain well. If the test is positive then the symptomatic person will need to isolate for at least 10 days. Please do not mix with other households during this time or allow the children to attend any clubs or outside engagements. Ensure you also inform school if your child or anyone in your household has a positive result – children will be provided with remote learning during the time they are off school. In adhering to these rules we help to keep each other safe and to keep the school operational as much as is possible.

Under the new government guidelines individuals are not required to self-isolate if they live in the same household as someone with COVID-19, or are a close contact of someone with COVID-19, and any of the following apply:

- •they are fully vaccinated
- •they are below the age of 18 years and 6 months
- •they have taken part in or are currently part of an approved COVID-19 vaccine trial
- •they are not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons

Instead, they will be contacted by NHS Test and Trace, informed they have been in close contact with a positive case and advised to take a PCR test. We would encourage all individuals to take a PCR test if advised to do so.

This will now mean that, unless informed otherwise by Public Health England, whole class 'bubbles' will no longer need to isolate if there is a positive case within the classroom.
